

# GRACE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL'S 2011-2012 TUITION AND FEES

## TUITION

The annual tuition may be paid using any of the following plans:

1. One payment – The full annual tuition is discounted 5% if paid by September 1<sup>st</sup>. The discount is forfeited and the account is converted to monthly if the full annual payment is not received by September 15<sup>th</sup>.
2. Installments. The first payment is due in June (12 month plan), August (10 months) or September (9 months). The remaining payments are drafted by FACTS on the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> (or next nearest business day) of each month.

Multi-student discounts for younger siblings (except half day kindergarten, which receives no discount) apply to tuition only, not to other fees. The 2<sup>nd</sup> child discount is 10%, the 3<sup>rd</sup> child discount is 20%, and all additional children are tuition free

Students entering during the school year will be charged a prorated amount for the portion of the first month that they are enrolled.

Withdrawal after the first full week of school will require payment for the first month's tuition.

## FEES

Application Fee.....\$25 at time of new student application, nonrefundable

Registration Fee.....\$150 if paid by March 31<sup>st</sup> (for returning students), \$200 thereafter; nonrefundable

Book Fees.....due July 1<sup>st</sup>, books distributed throughout year per curriculum

## GENERAL INFORMATION

All accounts must be paid in full by May 13<sup>th</sup> in order for report cards or permanent records to be released.

A \$25 fee is charged on all returned checks. If more than one check is returned, only cash, cashier's check, money order, Visa or MasterCard will be accepted.

Account payments are automatically drafted by FACTS on either the 5<sup>th</sup> or the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month (or the nearest business day thereafter). FACTS assesses a \$25.00 fee for each failed draft attempt, and reattempts on the next draft date approximately two weeks later. To avoid overburdening our clients with excessive debt, the school will financially withdraw students whose accounts fall more than 30 days past due. Students will be readmitted to class immediately when the account becomes current. Any work missed must be made up.

NO reimbursement will be made of any kind if student is expelled.

### GRACE CHRISTIAN DAY CARE FINANCIAL POLICY

The Day Care Fees are:

Two or less children - \$3.00 per hour

Third child - \$1.25 per hour

Four or more children – Free

Capping Points:

K-3 & K-4 - \$200.00 per month

K-5 to 12<sup>th</sup> - \$150.00 per month

There is a \$3.00 minimum charge. Day Care charges are reported to FACTS at the end of each month. FACTS will directly mail each family an invoice for Day Care charges which are due by the end of the following month. For example, students staying in the Day Care during September will receive a bill in October which must be paid by November 1<sup>st</sup>.

If a Day Care account becomes 30 days past due, students will be unable to remain in the Day Care. Students may continue in the Day Care when their account becomes current.

Day Care Hours are 7:00 a.m. – 7:45 a.m. and 12:00 – 6:00 p.m.

There will be an additional charge of **\$1.00 per minute** for each child not picked up by 6:00 p.m.

Day Care for 7<sup>th</sup> –12<sup>th</sup> grade students is called "After School Study Hall". The financial policy for After School Study Hall is identical to the Day Care policy.
